

Sock Scraps Granny Stripe

Size F crochet hook

Scraps of fingering weight yarn of any size

Finished blanket, as written, measures approximately 36-inches across. To add or subtract width, add or subtract beginning chain stitches in multiples of 4.

Glossary

st, sts: stitch or stitches

Ch, ch: chain

dc, DC: double crochet

rep: repeat

PATTERN

Chain 217 stitches. Turn.

1) 2 double crochet in 5th chain from hook. (3 dc in 4th ch over, ch 1) rep within () to last 4 ch sts. Ch 1, 3 dc in last ch st. Ch 4. Turn.

2) (3 dc in ea ch 1 space, ch 1) rep within () to last ch 4 space. DC once in this space. Ch 4. Turn.

3) 2 dc in 1st ch 4 space, ch 1. (3 dc in ea ch 1 space, ch 1) rep within () to last ch 4 space. 3 dc in this space. Ch 4. Turn.

4) (3 dc in ea ch 1 space, ch 1) rep within () to last group of 2 dc and ch 4. DC in the ch 4 of this set. Ch 4. Turn.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 to desired length.

**** to change colors:**

When you get to about the last 3-4 inches of current scrap being used, lay the new scrap to be used along the length of the remaining scrap, with the new end as close to your hook as possible. Continue to crochet as usual, holding both the new scrap and the old scrap together, until the old scrap is used up. Continue with just the new scrap. If there is a tiny end left hanging from one yarn or the other, just trim it off.
